What to include on your science board:

- 1. a clever title that includes your theme
- 2. a scene from the play that relates to your theme
- 3. a metaphor poem that your group creates (150 words, 2 vocab words, 2 lit devices other than metaphor, and a quote from the play)
- 4. a quote from another source (a well-known aphorism, adage, or proverb)
- 5. a picture of the character from *The Tragedy of Julius Caesar* who represents your theme, and an explanation why this character represents your theme, a quote from the play to support it
- 6. a picture of a famous person (current or from history) that represents your theme; provide justification for choosing this person and how she/he represents your theme
- 7. the characteristics of your theme (what it means) using two vocab words and one lit device (they cannot be ones you have already used)
- 8. a song of your choosing that represents your theme (include the lyrics and a justification for your selection, using specific examples from the play)
- 9. a cartoon or comic strip (one you create or one you find online) that represents your theme (and your justification for its use and how it relates to your theme)
- 10. two graphics/visuals that represent your theme
